

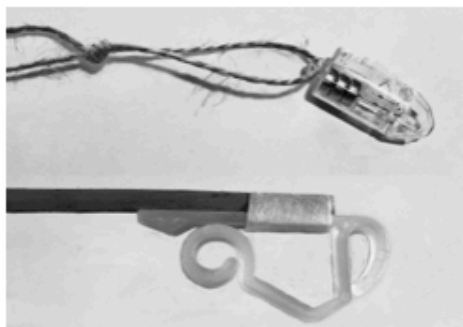
MAKING LANTERNS FOR "CHRISTMAS ON THE HILL" GATHERING - SATURDAY 23rd NOV

Gather with your lanterns in Market Hill at 4.15pm - the lighting up ceremony will start at 4.30pm with the entrance of giant lanterns made by the Fram Scouts & Guides, followed by Tree lighting and blessing

YOU WILL NEED:

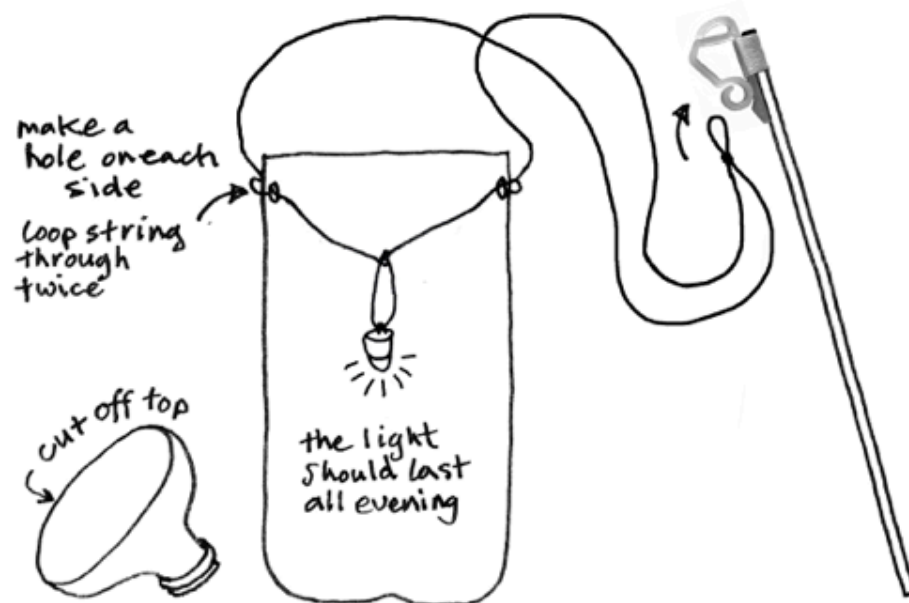
A Clear Plastic Water Bottle

- Scissors,
- Glue brush
- A tool to make holes
- Tissue paper
- PVA glue
- A long piece of thin string
- A hanging LED lantern lightbulb (available for free)
- A willow stick (available for free)
- Plastic safety hook



note: tea lights are not bright enough

MAKING THE LANTERN



Cut out Tissue Paper Shapes

Stars, trees, stripes, diamonds, squares... you can overlap two different coloured shapes to great effect.

Stick the shapes onto the bottle with PVA craft glue

Brush glue onto the bottle first, apply the tissue shapes, and brush more glue all over the top to give it a good finish.

Fix the plastic hook on to the stick with tape. Thread on the LED light as shown and make a loop to hang the lantern from the stick.
